6 August – 6 September 2021 (except Saturday, Sunday and public holiday)	Candidates can submit their specimens of postage-free election mail at any one of the following Hongkong Post offices:- General Post Office, Central G/F, Central Mail Centre, Kowloon Bay 10/F, Tsuen Wan Government Offices, Tsuen Wan 1/F, Sha Tin Government Offices, Sha Tin Remarks: (1) According to the latest legislative amendments, letters that may be posted free of postage must not be larger than 165 mm x 245 mm instead of 175 mm x 245 mm in size and must not exceed 5 mm in thickness; (2) To save time, candidates may consider submitting their specimens of postage-free election mail before being assigned with candidate number or confirming the printing details of the election mail; and (3) Once the specimens concerned have been approved in writing by Hongkong Post, candidates may insert the candidate number or printing details into the election mail without altering the approved design and content of the election mail. There is no need for the candidates to resubmit the revised specimens to Hongkong Post for approval.
6 August – 9 September 2021 (except Sunday and public holiday)	Candidates can post postage-free election mail at any one of 20 designated acceptance offices. (For details, please refer to the Appendix II of "Summary on Free Postage for Election Mail".) Remarks: (1) Candidates must select one of the acceptance offices where they intend to post their election mail when submitting the specimens and "Notice of Posting of Election Mail" to Hongkong Post; and (2) Candidates must furnish Hongkong Post with deposit if postings are made before the publication of notice of valid nominations in the Gazette.
