# 2005 Election Committee Subsector By-elections Reasons for Vacancies of Election Committee Members

Reasons for the 33 vacancies ascertained in the 17 subsectors of the Election Committee ("EC") are as follows:

#### (1) Accountancy subsector

Two vacancies arose because two members, namely, Messrs FAN Sheung-tak and FOK Kwan-wing had passed away;

#### (2) Agriculture and Fisheries subsector

Two vacancies arose because two members, namely, Messrs CHAN Chi-kong and CHENG For-yau had passed away;

# (3) Architectural, Surveying and Planning subsector

One vacancy arose because a member, Mr LAU Sau-shing, Patrick, having been elected as a Legislative Council ("LegCo") member, was deemed to have resigned from the EC on 8 October 2004;

# (4) Chinese People's Political Consultative Conference subsector

Two vacancies arose because one member, Mr WONG Ker-lee had passed away and another member, Mr LEE Hon-chiu had resigned from the EC:

#### (5) Chinese Medicine subsector

One vacancy arose because a member, namely, Mr POON Pak-sun had passed away;

# (6) Engineering subsector

Two vacancies arose because two members, namely, Messrs CHAN Nai-keong, Kenneth and YIM Chun-nam had passed away;

#### (7) Finance subsector

One vacancy arose because Mr LAM Kwong-siu, having been elected as a National People's Congress ("NPC") member, was deemed to have resigned from the EC on 21 March 2003;

## (8) Heung Yee Kuk subsector

Four vacancies arose because two members, namely, Messrs PANG Hang-yin and HO Sun-kuen had passed away; and two other members, namely, Messrs CHEUNG Hok-ming and LAM Wai-keung, having been elected as LegCo members, were deemed to have resigned from the EC on 8 October 2004;

## (9) <u>Higher Education subsector</u>

One vacancy arose because a member, Mr LEUNG Jin-pang had passed away;

# (10) Hong Kong and Kowloon District Councils subsector

Three vacancies arose because a member, Mr LIANG Tin had passed away; another two members, namely, Ms KO Po-ling, having been elected as a NPC member, and Mr WONG Kwok-hing, having been elected as a LegCo member, were deemed to have resigned from the EC on 21 March 2003 and 8 October 2004 respectively;

# (11) <u>Import and Export subsector</u>

One vacancy arose because a member, Mr WONG Ting-kwong, having been elected as a LegCo member, was deemed to have resigned from the EC on 8 October 2004;

#### (12) Industrial (First) subsector

Two vacancies arose because two members, namely, Messrs LAM Kin-fung, Jeffrey and LEUNG Kwan-yuen, Andrew, both having been elected as LegCo members, were deemed to have resigned from the EC on 8 October 2004;

# (13) Industrial (Second) subsector

One vacancy arose because a member, Mr LAM Hok-po had passed away;

#### (14) <u>Labour subsector</u>

One vacancy arose because a member, Mr WONG Kwok-kin, having been elected as a NPC member, was deemed to have resigned from the EC on 21 March 2003;

#### (15) <u>Legal subsector</u>

Two vacancies arose because two members, namely, Messrs LEONG Kah-kit, Alan and TONG Ka-wah, both having been elected as LegCo members, were deemed to have resigned from the EC on 8 October 2004;

## (16) Religious subsector

Six vacancies arose because five members, namely, Messrs TONG Kwok-wah, CHIU Chung-tong, CHU Chor-sing, David, KU Sze-chung and YAU Fu-hong had passed away; and a member, Ms HASSAN Rubbya had resigned from the EC; and

#### (17) <u>Textiles and Garment subsector</u>

One vacancy arose because a member, Mr LEE Chung-chiu had passed away.
