Note for Submission of a Text Version of Introduction to Candidates
for the Visually Impaired**

In order to assist the visually-impaired in reading the contents of the election platform in the Introduction to Candidates, the Registration and Electoral Office (“REO”) will produce a text version of Introduction to Candidates for uploading onto the website: <http://www.reo.gov.hk>. This version would contain only typed texts including the candidate numbers as shown on the ballot paper, name, age, occupation, political affiliation, e-mail address/ website of each candidate. For the election platform, the contents should be the same as that of the original candidate platform. While provision of such a version to the REO is optional, candidates are encouraged to do so.

How to Submit

Please send the completed Form for Submission of a Text Version of Introduction to Candidates for the Visually Impaired by e-mail to e-intro_to_can@reo.gov.hk by 5:00 p.m., 13 August 2014. If a candidate does not submit the file by the said deadline, only the name and candidate number of the candidate and the words “Relevant information has not been provided by the candidate” will be shown in the appropriate area of the form. In normal circumstance, similar to the processing of the original version of Introduction to Candidates, the REO will not edit the contents provided by the candidate for the text version unless they are not in typed text form or are different from that of the original version of Introduction to Candidates.
