Key dates	Procedures
<p>4 October – 6 November 2019 (except Saturday, Sunday and public holiday)</p>	<p>Candidates can submit their specimens of postage-free election mails at the respective Hongkong Post offices designated to their constituencies.</p> <p>(For details, please refer to the Appendix II of “Summary on Free Postage for Election Mail”.)</p> <p><u>Remarks :</u></p> <p>(1) To save time, candidates may consider submitting their specimens of postage-free election mails before being assigned with candidate number or confirming the printing details of the election mails; and</p> <p>(2) Once the specimens concerned have been approved in writing by Hongkong Post, candidates may insert the candidate number or printing details into the election mails <u>without altering the approved design and content of the election mails.</u> There is no need for the candidates to re-submit the revised specimens to Hongkong Post for approval.</p>
<p>4 October – 11 November 2019 (except Sunday and public holiday)</p>	<p>Candidates can post postage-free election mails at the respective acceptance offices designated to their constituencies.</p> <p>(For details, please refer to the Appendix II of “Summary on Free Postage for Election Mail”.)</p> <p><u>Remark :</u></p> <p>Candidates must furnish Hongkong Post with deposit if postings are made before the publication of notice of valid nominations in the Gazette.</p>
