

2020 Legislative Council General Election

Notes on Submission of a Text Version of Introduction to Candidates for Persons with Visual Impairment

In order to assist persons with visual impairment in reading the contents of the Introduction to Candidates, the Registration and Electoral Office (“REO”) will produce a text version of Introduction to Candidates for uploading onto the election dedicated website of the 2020 Legislative Council General Election: <https://www.elections.gov.hk>. This version will contain only typed texts including the letter of the alphabet or number of the candidate/candidate list as shown on the ballot paper, name, age, occupation, political affiliation of each candidate, and e-mail address and website of the candidate/candidate list. For the electoral message, the textual contents must be the same as those of the original version of Introduction to Candidates. While the provision of the text version to the REO is optional, **candidates are strongly encouraged to do so to convey their electoral messages to persons with visual impairment.**

How to Complete

Please type the text with the use of computer in the appropriate area provided in a Form for Submission of a Text Version of Introduction to Candidates for Persons with Visual Impairment which can be downloaded via the following link or QR code. How to Submit

Please send the completed Form for Submission of a Text Version of Introduction to Candidates for Persons with Visual Impairment by e-mail to e-intro_to_can@reo.gov.hk by 5:00 p.m. on 7 August 2020. If a candidate/candidate list does not submit the form by the said deadline, only the name and letter of the alphabet or number of the candidate/candidate list as shown on the ballot paper and the words “Relevant information has not been provided by the candidate” will be shown in the appropriate area of the text version. In normal circumstances, similar to the production process of the original version of Introduction to Candidates, the REO will not edit the contents provided by the candidate/candidate list for the text version unless they are not in typed text form or are different from those of the original version of Introduction to Candidates.
