2021 Legislative Council General Election Notes on Submission of a Form for Submission of a Text Version of Introduction to Candidates for Persons with Visual Impairment

In order to assist persons with visual impairment in reading the contents of the Introduction to Candidates, the Registration and Electoral Office ("REO") will produce a text version of Introduction to Candidates for uploading to the dedicated 2021 Legislative Council General website of the Election This version will contain only texts typed by (https://www.elections.gov.hk). computer, including the alphabet or number of the candidate as shown on the ballot paper, name, age, occupation, political affiliation, email address and website of the candidate. For the electoral message, the textual contents must be the same as those of the original version of Introduction to Candidates. While candidates can choose whether to provide the text version, the REO strongly encourages candidates to do so to convey their electoral messages to persons with visual impairment.

Please type the text with the use of computer in the appropriate area provided in a "Form for Submission of a Text Version of Introduction to Candidates for Persons with Visual Impairment" which can be downloaded via the following link or QR code. How to Submit

Please send the completed "Form for Submission of a Text Version of Introduction to Candidates for Persons with Visual Impairment" by email to e-intro_to_can@reo.gov.hk on or before 22 November 2021 at 5:00 p.m. If a candidate does not submit that form on or before the above deadline, only the name and the alphabet or number of the relevant candidate as shown on the ballot paper will be printed and the words "Relevant information has not been provided by the candidate" will be shown in the appropriate area of the text version. Similar to the production process of the original version of the Introduction to Candidates, in normal circumstances, the REO will not edit the contents provided by the candidate for the text version unless they are not texts typed by computer or are different from those of the original version of the Introduction to Candidates.
